

























## Jewellery and traditional items from Kastellorizo

**Left column** from top: *Haimali* (child's amulet)). Child's amulet - Gold coin with bead and attachment; Cufflinks with 1915 & 1925 coins. D*iliro* American Gold Eagle \$10 coin 1896.

**Centre column**: *Haimali* with coins attached. Sasouna – silver whistle – traditional gift for young boys. *Boukles* – used to fasten the *Poukamiso* (chemise). *Stravoflouri* - gold pendant with Victorian gold coin 1878, Austrian coin 4 Ducats (*matzaria*), set in pendant.

**Right column**: Silver pectoral type cross on long chain – usually given to boys.

Two gold coins – Venetian ducats/*Konstantinata*.

Gold sovereigns 1909 &1914. Traditional Kastellorizian *Tserkeno* bracelet.

**Below** from left: Brooch from Rhodes with depiction of a Deer symbolic of the goddess Artemis. Pearl and gold ring. Gold bracelet with stones. Gold coin (Emperor Justinian) surrounded by gold filigree. Traditional gold bangle.
