The Paspalis Family The Paspalev Family

Property Pearling, investment (diverse) Darwin, Sydnev. The Greek village of Castellorizo near the Turkish border was the birthplace of two brothers who were to have a tremendous impact on the Northern Territory.

Arriving in Australia in 1918 Mick Paspalis and Nick Paspaley (Nick changed his surname to avoid confusion in mail deliveries) came to Darwin via Port Hedland in 1927 and established a business empire that included pearling property and ice cream.

To-day Mick's widow Chrissie heads the Paspalis family and Nick's three children Nick, Roslynne & Marilynne (of the G.P. Television series) have inherited their fathers pearling industry mantle and are estimated to control about 60 % of the market.

Chrissie who has 2 daughters Helen Coombes & Phynea Paroulakis, lives in Sydney where she has built up a property port folio centred on Bondi Junction and the Sydney C.B.D. She is now in her late 70's very much a private person and in a rare interview she once despaired about the extravagance of today's society. "I didn't go overseas until 1963 when I was 50" she said. "To-day children think its their privilege to go overseas and have a good time" - 100 million.

Con Polites

Property, Adelaide 73 married with 3 children Con Polites' Princes Corporation owns more than 30 properties in the Adelaide C.B.D.

Most of the properties are down at heel and many are located in the city entertainment strip Hindley Street. The flamboyant Polites is the son of a coal miner-turnedmarket gardener who migrated from Greece in 1915 settling in Port Pirie S.A. Polites left School at 15 to work as a shoe repairer before his father set him up in a delicatessen. After two years he sold the business and worked for Woolworths. He managed a munitions factory during World War 2 before moving into Real Estate. Polites whose opulent hilltop home in the Adelaide suburb of Pasadena is known locally as "the White House" is not slowing down despite his advancing years. "I have no intentions of retiring until I die" he says.

Although his portfolio suffered from the decline in property values he has held it for a long time. His son George works in the business. Con is married to Flora (Gemenis) a well know Castellorizian family of Sydney N.S.W. - 30 million.
