PASSIONATE PURVEYOR OF WORDS, KOMNINOS ZERVOS, WINS PRESTIGIOUS AWARD

Performance poet Komninos this year was awarded the 1992 Ros Bower Memorial Award. Established in 1981 the \$20,000 annual award recognises outstanding achievement in the community arts.

The award was presented by Robyn Archer, one of Australia's most celebrated performers and writers, and Chair of the Australia Council's Community Cultural Development Board. The Ros Bower Award is Australia's richest community art prize and symbolises the Board's commitment to maximising opportunities for all Australians to participate actively in the arts.

Robyn Archer says: "Komninos' capacity to make poetry out of the everyday experience of life is inspirational to the many people he contacts through his writing, his teaching and his community-based work. The award particularly recognises his contribution through his work with children and young people. Komninos' communication of this experience of being a Greek-Australian contributes to a greater understanding of the complexities of life in a multicultural Australia".

Komninos has been described variously as a bard, a troubadour and an 'unorthodox archbishop of poetry'. His writing validates and celebrates the lives of ordinary Australians. Komninos will celebrate with friends and colleagues at the award presentation ceremony at the Australian National Word Festival (University House) Canberra.

Komninos Zervos, 42, a working class bear of a man, has been changing people's perceptions of poetry through 'poeting' for nearly a decade. With three volumes of poetry published, Komninos waxes, "I've performed in every venue in Australia". He took outback Queensland by storm on the Writer's Train tours of the far west in 1990 and 1992. These tours, along with an exhaustive program of community residencies around the country in the past few years, have established Komninos' reputation as a great community artist, a true poet of the people.

Komninos came to the attention of the Community Cultural Development Board of the Australia Council, which administers the Ros Bower Award, through his outstanding work with socially disadvantaged boys at St. Vincent's Adolescent Care, Westmead Hospital. His project entitled "Find Your Own Voice" encouraged the boys, some illiterate or dyslexic or with behavioural problems, to write. For many of them the 'poeting' process liberated their perceptions of both themselves and the world around them.

Ros (Rosalie) Bower (1923-1980)

'The arts should not be seen to be incarcerated in respectability. Nor should they be isolated physically or psychologically, from the broader concept of people's culture".

Ros Bower was the first Director of the Australia Council's Community Arts Board. She worked tirelessly to create the firm base on which community arts in Australia has developed.

The Ros Bower Memorial Trust each year awards an 'outstanding individual or project which demonstrates distinguished effort in furthering the philosophies and practice espoused by Ros Bower'.

Along with a cheque for \$20,000, Komninos was presented with two framed multi-media artworks, by commissioned artist, Julie Savage.
