

Professor BYRON ARTHUR KAKULAS, A.O.

Division, 1983-1984; Foundation Director, Australian Brain Foundation, 1970; Chairman, International Sc. Adv. Committee, Muscular Dystrophy Trust Cyprus, since 1989; Hellenism Award, Greek Australian Professional and Businessmen's Association W.A., 1989; Advance Australia Award, 1989; Didaktora (Hon Causa), University of Athens, 1979. Author of several books and a number of papers on Muscular Dystrophy, Neuropathology, Muscle Disease and Spinal Cord Injury. Born March 29, 1932, Perth. "The Castellorizian of the Year is awarded once in each year to a person of castellorizian descent whose achievements in the State, National and International arenas, or areas such as social, community or cultural development, scholarly research or scientific and economic development, are an inspiration to the Castellorizian communities of Australia and an example to the generations that will follow.
