Eulogy of the Late Evangelia. G. Koutsoukis

(nee Savas)

Our mother and grandmother lived a long life. In a few minutes it would be difficult to talk about such a life but there is much about Evangelia Koutsoukis we, her family, would like to share with you today.

She was born in 1903 and spent her early years on Castellorizo. Marrying her beloved husband George Koutsoukis in 1923, they chose to migrate to Western Australia where their children Nina, Con and Lily were born. Remarkably, she made this arduous journey twice and after arriving and then returning to a business venture in Egypt. She then returned to Australia in 1934 with her husband and four children, Marika having been born in Egypt. They were penniless.

Evangelia, together with her husband George had to struggle to establish themselves in a new country, this time in Melbourne.

Throughout her life, Evangelia demonstrated an unwavering commitment to family. She was called upon to demonstrate this a number of times in her life.

Following the death of her widowed sister Katina, she took on the role of guardian of the Hetrelezis children. Bazil, Margaret and Melody who remembered that she was always there for them after the death of their parents. They describe her as a guiding light in their early years.

Evangelia had to comfort two tragic events within her family. The death of her husband George and later her son Con. Both events had a profound effect on her. She was supported through these events and throughout her life by her great faith in God and her devout belief in the Greek Orthodox Church As Evangelia often said, $E\chi\epsilon\tau$ o $\Theta\epsilon$ o ς

She remained a great comfort to many during her life but in particular to her grand daughter, her namesake, Vivien who describes her as a loyal friend who provided love and understanding always. Loved dearly by her daughters Nina and Lily, and their husbands Michael and Peter.

The last forty years of her life she spent at the centre of Jack and Marika Bisas. Her daily devotion and involvement in every aspect of the life of the Bisas family will ensure that she will remain permanently in their memory. The Bisas grandchildren are grateful for the opportunity to have her so close for so long.

Evangelia was often described as a Grand Lady - that she was indeed!

She was held in very high esteem, generous of heart, loyal and much loved. She had a serenity and calmness and gentle nature which influenced many others.

Evangelia was a proud Castellorizian, devout Christian, devoted mother grandmother and great-grandmother (16 grandchildren, 24 great-grandchildren). She lived a long full life which would be impossible to explain in a few short minutes.

It is enough to say that her impact on our lives has left a special place in all of our hearts.

To many people in the family she represented a symbol of everything that was important about family: stability, love, devotion, and reliability.

We will always love her.

We miss her.

We were privileged to have known her.
