

HOUSE FULL! Our first function for 1983, a TV Tape Evening, was a great success with approximately 200 members present. We were privileged to see the best tape ever made of the island of Castellorizo. It was most gratifying to the Committee to see so many new and old faces at this first Function.

However, it once again shows the inadequacies of our Club Rooms - catering for 200 people is beyond the facilities as they are now.

A replay of the tape for members who missed out, or those who wish to see it again will be held at our Club Rooms on Sunday, the 20th of February, in conjunction with the first of a series of lectures to be sponsored by your Society. Details are included in this Newsletter.

SOCIAL SUB-COMMITTEE: It is with pleasure that we announce the formation of a Social Sub-Committee. The role of this sub-committee is to take over and organise all functions and social events held by our Society. We thank the following members for their acceptance of our invitation to be on this Committee:- Mrs. Joyce Pallaras, Mr. Peter Coates, Mr. & Mrs. George A. Adgemis, Mrs. Dianne Spartels. We still require 2 more to assist!

While on the subject of Sub-Committees, the Committee has decided to form a Welfare Sub-Committee to visit and assist Castellorians, who are ill in hospital or need assistance. We will pay travelling expenses and other incidental costs. We are looking for a sub-committee of three. If you are interested in helping others not as well off as ourselves, please contact our Secretary, Mrs. E. Pavlou by ringing 598 2925. We thank you.

The Committee will commence as soon as funds are available to write the History of the Castellorizians in Victoria. This work, which we hope will commence before the end of 1983, will be prepared by an historian and ensure a lasting record of our history. We anticipate that the cost will be approximately \$7500 - \$5000 for wages and \$2500 for ancillary costs. Because of the importance of this project to ourselves and to the State of Victoria, where we have now been established as a brotherhood for 58 years, we have made application to the Australia Council and the Bi Centennial Committee for funds to finance this project.

Your Committee has been very active in inspecting properties for future Development in line with the Motion passed at our Annual General Meeting. We have inspected properties at 114 Lonsdale Street, Brunswick Street in Fitzroy, Flinders Street in the City and Victoria Street in North Melbourne. None of these have been satisfactory. However, we have now been offered premises at Springvale. The property is the Springvale RSL Club, which is fully licenced, has a capacity for 300 people, car park, and a house next door on a large block of land for future development.

Catering facilities are excellent. It contains bar facilities, billiard rooms and is built in a residential area. It was recently passed in at auction for \$250,000. The property would not be available for 12 months. Its present rental would be \$700 per week. Your committee will inspect and keep you informed.
