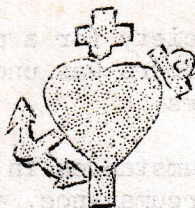

At a Joint Meeting held on Monday, 18th November, with the outgoing Committee, the New Board put into Motion - the following Motions passed at the Annual General Meeting:

"That a new lease be given to the current tenants at an increased rental of \$300 per week, plus the payment of all M.M.B.W. rates and City of South Melbourne rates for the whole building, including the Club Rooms."

This offer has been accepted by the tenants and a new lease will be prepared by the Club's Honorary Solicitors, Zervos & Company.

A further Motion was also passed: "That renovations of the present Club Rooms be carried out, e.g., Replacement of Curtains, Repainting of Interior, Repair of all Toilet Floor areas".

A 3rd Motion: "That the New Committee prepare and present amendments to the Current Constitution at a Special Annual Meeting of Members, or at the Annual General Meeting".

The Past Committee who served the Society for a period of three years agreed that the retirement of all seven Board Members was undesirable and should be changed to a rotating change of Committee Members.

As members should be aware, the circumstances in 1982 were such that a period of stability was needed, and in this circumstance, and only in these conditions, did Members agree to serve the Society for three years. I am sure that the degree of stability that was required in 1982 has now been achieved.

I do not propose to list the achievements or dedicated workload that those members gave to the Society, but just to say in this final Newsletter, and on my behalf, "Thank you for a great effort over the past 3 years."

Not much recognition or thanks are ever forthcoming from members, but I would say that you should be proud of your 3 years' work for the Society.

NEWS IN BRIEF FROM CASTELLORIZO:

The following News item appeared in the Press on 15th November, 1985.

It is of interest to all second and third generation Kastellorizians, and in particular, paragraph 3. The article is written by Ann Mouzak, M.D.

"A summary of the topographical survey conducted by Professor Dionysis Balodimos, pertaining to Kastellorizo's land area, was published in the previous issues of August and September 1985 of the Kastellorizian News.

Our compatriots from all over the world are requested to co-operate with the municipality of Kastellorizo in order for their properties to be registered, and accomplished so, properly. The registration will be transacted according to the recently formed topographical map and will be based upon official documents.

Ownerships up to the third generation have been cleared. Estates which have not been claimed will be confiscated by the municipality which, in turn, will distribute the land to the permanent residents of Megisti. Necessity of such distribution will be accomplished through an official raffle.

The Fourth Dodecanesian Cultural Convention took place at the Holy Abbey of Panormitou of Simi on August 28- to September 1st, 1985.

On Sunday, the 15th September, 1985, the liberation of Kastellorizo from the Axis countries during the Second World War on the historic day of September 13, 1943, was celebrated on the island with great festivity. Among the honored guests was the Minister of the Aegean, Mr. K. Sphyriou. It is recorded that Kastellorizo was the first Greek land area to be liberated in the World War 11 liberation of Greece.

It is with great pleasure in announcing the opening of our medical dispensary on the island. All are overwhelmingly enthused with its operation.
