

EARLY HISTORY OF WEST AUSTRALIAN CASTELLORIZIAN

The first Castellorizian to arrive in Perth was Athanasios Auguste, a 14 year-old boy who fled his island home in 1884 after an assault on a Turkish official. He worked as a laborer with the Suez Canal Authority for four years and determined to take one of the south-bound ships to distant Australia. He landed in Broome, via Singapore, in 1888, worked in the pearling industry, tripped around the bush and reached Perth in 1895, where he later founded the old oyster beds restaurant on the Swan River at East Fremantle.
