BOARD OF DIRECTORS REPORT - SEPTEMBER, 1987

The Annual General Meeting of the Castellorizian Association of Victoria was held at our Club rooms on 30th August, 1987. 44 Members attended the Meeting where it was reported to Members, that the tenant has caused a few problems as regards the current lease, namely his failure to sign and also by not paying the rates. Our Solicitor assures us that the matter has now been resolved, but the members will be informed if there are any further developments.

Motions put to the meeting and passed were:-

TRIBUTE TO ANTHONY G. VOYAGE

Tony was born in Castellorizo in 1922. At the age of 10 he went to live in Rhodes for 15 years, and during this time served with the British Military and was listed as missing for two years. Migrated to Perth and then came to Melbourne where he completed his education at the Melbourne University.

He married Katina Kanis in 1950. Katina was the only daughter of John and Nina Kanis. Tony was a most generous man, benefactor and philanthropist. His many donations to hospitals, churches, Hostel for the Frailed Age, and to many needy individuals were made anonymously (with only the knowledge of family and friends).

The extent and scope of his generosity, his devotion and assistance to his immediate and extended family was indicative of the type of person he was. He was a man whose foresight took him into China in 1954 and was one of the first (if not the first) to realise the huge potential of China. He founded the importing firm of A.G. Voyage and made over 50 trips to China. In his lifetime his standing in China is reflected in the many outstanding tributes sent to his family by his many Chinese friends.
