The programme for the Weekend has changed slightly and the following is the final programme.

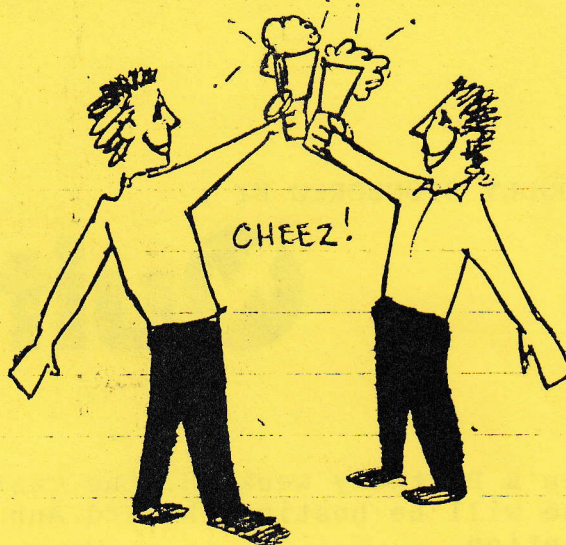

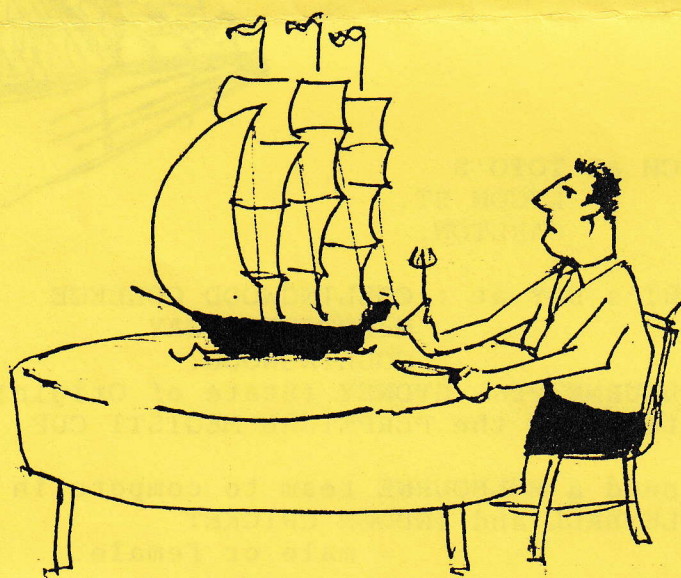
