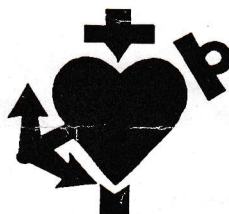

VLASSIOS ZANAELIS

In the Australian National Gallery hangs a painting by a Greek Australian artist whose name was Vlassios Zanaelis, but signed his works as Vlass Zanalis.

Vlassios was born in Kastellorizo in 1902 from where he migrated to Perth in 1914 when he was 12 years old. He studied art in Perth and from 1920 onwards he concentrated on the study of the culture and painted scenes from the life of Australian Aborigines - The Koorie.

Vlassios lived for a long time among the Koorie of Kimberleys and was even initiated into the Dadaway Tribe. It is also said that he painted the Icons in the Church of St. Constantine & St. Helen in Perth. He died in 1972.

Apart from this, little else is known about his life and family background and the Greek Australian archives are interested in collecting details about him from people who knew hi, or knew of him or his family.
